From Cardiff: leave the M4 at Junction 42 and proceed along Fabian Way (A483) to Swansea. After crossing the river Tawe continue along Oystermouth Road. After the traffic lights outside the Leisure Centre, move into the far right lane to turn right at the next set of traffic lights just beyond the large Tesco store. After this right turn, move into the left hand lane and continue straight ahead through several sets of traffic lights. At the T-junction at the end of this road, stay in the left lane but turn right along the Kingsway. After the next set of lights the road will lead you around to the left up a short hill (Christina Street) and the left lane will turn left into Mansel Street at the top of the hill. Continue up Mansel Street for a short distance until you come to a crossroads. Turn right into Calvert Terrace. At the next junction, one road goes off to the left and two roads lead uphill to your right. Take the higher road on the right, which leads up a steep hill to a blind corner. The Trust premises occupy a stone building, fronted by a car park surfaced in grey chippings, on your left as you round the corner. The entrance is a few metres along from the corner.

From the station the Trust's premises are approximately 15-20 minutes walk. Visitors should cross High Street and continue via Alexandra Road, across a second set of traffic lights, past the Glynn Vivian Art Gallery to a third set of traffic lights at the junction of Grove Place and Mount Pleasant. Turn right, then first left into Heathfield. At the western end of Heathfield, turn left and follow the stone boundary wall to the main entrance.
